

CAFS report for Jan 2013

We would like to wish all CAFS members a Happy New Year and look forward to seeing you all again when the season recommences with "Warhorse" on Fri 11th Jan 2013 at 7.30pm in Caldbeck Village Hall.

The film is based on Michael Morpurgo's book about a farm horse called Joey. Joey does his best on the farm, although not a draught horse and is cared for by a young man called Albert. When war breaks out he is conscripted to become a cavalry horse in World War I. Joey sees life on both sides of the lines before he is saved from all his trials.

The film lasts for 146 mins and has a (12A) certificate. It was directed by Stephen Spielberg and so has a slightly different tone from the book. There are scenes of warfare, which are not suitable for younger children. However, the film is suitable for older children and we are making a **SPECIAL OFFER** on tickets of 1 adult plus up to 2 children between 12-16 for £6. Adult tickets cost £4.
